Include student's name in the upper right-hand corner of each page of the application materials. Application materials not containing the applicant's name will not be considered.

- Most recent high school (and college if applicable) transcript (official copies are not necessary).
- A statement that briefly describes your extracurricular activities, community involvement (including the number of hours served), work experience and achievements.
- A student's statement in which you provide background information about yourself. Describe your intended course of study and why you have chosen to pursue a career in financial management (300 words or less)
- One letter of recommendation from an employer or teacher, addressing your abilities and accomplishments
