



## Requirements to paint your parking spot:

- Cost 1: Must have completed the and purchased a parking permit, which included the \$40 parking fee.
- Cost 2: Pay additional \$20 to be able to paint the parking spot.
- Cost 3: Students must purchase their own paint and supplies to be able to paint their parking spot on the assigned day:
- Cost 4: Must be cleared of all FEES and FINES

#### **Design Requirements:**

- Parking spot design must be completed and approved by your administrator prior to painting.
- Must be school-appropriate
  - No offensive language or symbols
  - No double meanings
  - No use of other people's names (ONLY your own name)
- You are not permitted to deviate from your submitted design nor alter your design at any time.
- Prohibited items will be painted over in gray at the discretion of the administration and disciplinary action may be taken.

#### Materials Needed (Suggested):

- Latex paint Exterior Water Based
  - \* NO oil based paints \* NO reflective paints \* NO spray paint
- Brushes, rollers or sponge to apply paint
- Masking tape to mark off 4 inch border from white lines
- Broom to sweep dirt before painting
- Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans
- Plastic containers for water, paint and brushes

## Painting Tips and Guidelines:

- Tape the edges of your spot with a 4-INCH margin before painting.
- Do not paint on the white lines, parking lot curbs, or the parking space number.
- Sweep the dirt and pebbles off the spot before you paint.
- Use chalk to draw out your sketch.
- Start painting at the front of your spot out to the end (front bumper to back bumper).
- Share paint with friends to cut down on the cost.

## Approved Dates for Painting:

- Design approved before painting
- Painting Dates: Saturday, August 24 (8:00-12:00) & Saturday, August 31 (8:00-12:00).
- All spaces must be painted over with **FLAT GRAY PAINT** on **Friday**, **May 2nd** or you will be charged a **\$30 repaint fee** at graduation check out
