Mini-Lesson	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Connect each lesson to ongoing student work.• Teach a skill or strategy to help students as readers.• Model thinking processes.• Read a variety of texts aloud.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be an active listener.• Turn and talk, and stop to write thoughts down to hold on to or grow understanding.• Participate in conversations.
Work Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Confer with individual students.• Meet with small groups.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read independently.• Solve problems independently.• Grow thinking by writing.
Share	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Share the thoughts and work of individuals.• Share the thoughts and work of small groups.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Share thoughts and work from the lessons.• Listen to others' ideas and work.
